Other Information:

- Rowan County residents who are not registered and wish to vote in the Municipal Elections must have been registered by October 11, 2019. A voter who has moved since the last election must have made a change to their address by the same date. All voter registrations/change forms must have been postmarked no later than October 11, 2019 or in our office by 5 pm, October 11, 2019, to be a valid application to register for this election.
- Any registered voter who cannot go to the polls to vote on Election Day can request an absentee ballot to be mailed to them. Requests must be made on the State Absentee Ballot Request Form. Absentee ballot requests must be in our office by 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 29th. Requests can be found at:
