



Absentee By Mail Voting in 2022 General Election

Any North Carolina registered voter may request, receive, and vote a mail-in absentee ballot. No special circumstance or reason is needed. Registered voters in North Carolina must request an absentee ballot with an official N.C. Absentee Ballot Request Form. There are two ways to access and submit the form:

1. Online with “**Option 1 – Request an Absentee Ballot**” at the [N.C. Absentee Ballot Portal](#).
2. Online pre-fill your information & print request form then mail to Board of Elections with the [N.C. Absentee Ballot Request Form](#)

Absentee-By-Mail Date or Deadline

September 9, 2022: The date by which the boards of elections must make available absentee ballots, barring any action by the State Board or the courts to postpone that date, under [N.C.G.S. 163-227.10\(a\)](#).

October 14, 2022: Civilian voter registration deadline for the 2022 statewide general.

November 1, 2022: Deadline for civilians to submit an absentee ballot request form for the 2022 statewide general.

November 8, 2022: Election Day for the 2022 statewide general and civilian absentee ballot return deadline.
